Historical Society Beginnings

The first meeting for the St. Michael Historical Society was April 11, 2005. The Society incorporated on July 29th and received membership with the Minnesota Historical Society in August. Tax-Exempt status was granted in early 2006.

We had a booth at Heritage Day and Fall Festival September 2005. Tours of the Historic Church were shown and a video of the 1990 Centennial celebration of the City of St. Michael. A pamphlet with a brief history of St. Michael was made available. New members joined and photos were shared. The November 7th meeting included a slide presentation of St. Michael in 1900 by Bob Zahler, about 50 people attended. On December 5th Bob Zahler gave an aerial slide presentation of St. Michael in 1954 with about 35 people attending.

In August we received several photos of Home Talent Plays and Actors Play Books. We began identifying the people in the pictures and plan to make a scrapbook . Also in August we received five items of memorabilia of the St. Michael Catholic Historic Church.

On February 6th, 2006 we began collecting photos of farms in the St. Michael area and will be making a scrapbook of them. Also on February 6th Doug Ohman gave a slide presentation on Barns of Minnesota. The Society has accomplished much in this first year. St. Michael City Hall graciously provided a meeting room, mailing address, phone with voice mail and helped with the filing fees. We are grateful for their support and to the St. Michael America Legion for their donation. We also would like to thank the St. Michael Historical Church Preservation Committee and the St. Michael Lions for partnering with us at the Heritage Day & Fall Festival last September.



"Village at Dusk"

The St. Michael Historical Society has commissioned SPELTZ STUDIO OF WILDLIFE to produce an original oil painting that depicts a St. Michael Street Scene from 1910 called "Village at Dusk." The romantic sunrise scene showcases the picturesque Downtown architectural area. This historical rendition includes the Golden Corner Hotel and Saloon est.1897; the Old Telephone Building est.1910; Zachman-Blom General Merchandise Store and Post Office est. 1878; Village Hall est.1904; H.W. Dick Implement est. 1906; St. Michael State Bank est. 1905; Church Rectory est.1881; and Historic Church of St. Michael est.1890.

Speltz Studio produces a limited edition set of lithography prints from each original painting. These prints are hand-signed and numbered for authenticity. When matted, the print size becomes a standard 16"x20". These prints can be personalized with your choice of pencil Remarque sketch. Family name or children's names can be added. Proceeds will benefit the newly founded Historical Society to establish a museum fund for a future library and archival storage area for historical photos and data.

J.D. Speltz has produced an abundant collection of favorite landmark scenes from across the United States. The studio has been the recipient of ten state stamps and six national awards. Each original painting displays their time-consuming style and a story told dramatically in glowing colors. In every painting you will find a number of small sparrows somewhere on the canvas. These represent the less visible people who play a part in the development of the project.

The prints will retail for \$35.00 each. Mats and frames from Speltz Studio can also be purchased for a reasonable price.
